decline was used by many buyers and sellers to balance their position and by the end of October buying and selling interests were more nearly on an even keel than they have been for a good while.

COPRA: October arrivals were very heavy indeed and while not up to those of 1933 in Manila, were the best we have had so far this year. Cebu arrivals were thirty per cent over 1933 figures. These heavy arrivals may be attributed very largely to the high prices predominating in September which distinctly encouraged copra production. The market drop also stimulated the marketing of copra, sellers fearing lower prices later on. The first of October the price of copra was P6.00 per hundred kilos Resecondo in Manila but by the end of the month this figure was down to P5.10 with comparatively little buying interest and sellers unwilling to contract except for stocks actually in hand.
